o Attended

- o All parliamentary group and highlighted the issue of care of children with diabetes in school
- o House of Lords has since amended the Bill to include a statutory duty for schools to support children with long-term conditions, including Type 1 diabetes.
- o Schools have a clear responsibility to look after the children. OFSTED will monitor this
- o Emphasis on school health nurses
- o No mention of need for specialist nurses to be involved so more lobbying being done
- o Due to start Sept 2014
