POSITION STATEMENT ON FREESTYLE LIBRE FOR GLUCOSE MONITORING

The Regional Medicines Optimisation Committee (RMOC) has made a recommendation on the cost-effective use of FreeStyle Libre published on 1st November 2017. This position is now endorsed by the Northern Treatment Advisory Group for patients in the North East and Cumbria, by Greater Manchester Medicines Group for patients in Greater Manchester, by the Area Prescribing Committee in Brighton and by Health Technology Wales.

Please note that there is a criteria to commit to ongoing regular follow-up and monitoring and that audit data from all patients must be submitted. FreeStyle Libre data from children's diabetes units will be included in the national Association of British Clinical Diabetologists (ABCD) audit as part of a collaboration between ABCD and ACDC.
