### ACDC NEW GUIDELINE DEVELOPMENT GROUP

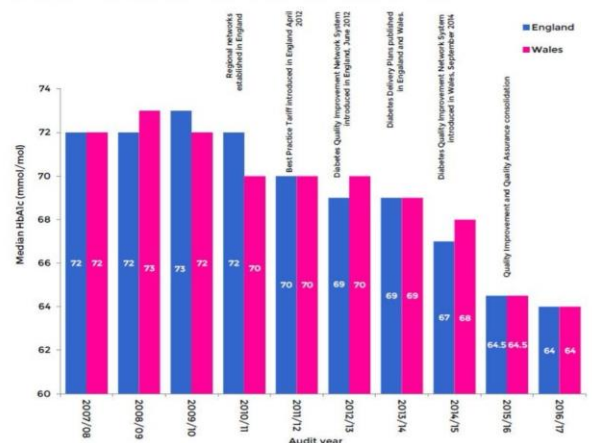

Results show that children and young people's diabetes management has improved for the 7th consecutive year, with increasing numbers of children and young people with Type 1 Diabetes achieving excellent control.
