ACDC REPRESENTED AT THE ALL-PARTY PARLIAMENTARY GROUP FOR TYPE 2 DIABETES IN CHILDREN

Dr Fiona Regan represented the ACDC at the APPG group for Type 2 Diabetes on the 16th May 2019. Between 2005 and 2015, there has been a 30% increase in the number of children and young people with Type 2 diabetes and there is a call for more research into Type 2 diabetes medications in children and young people, better access to community paediatric dietitians and a ban of unhealthy food advertising aimed at children.
