NICE UPDATE JULY 2016

NICE released a new quality standards on Diabetes in Children and Young People published July 2016 which describes high priority areas for quality improvement in diabetes care. It draws on the existing 2015 NICE NG18 guidance and provides an underpinning and comprehensive set of recommendations designed to support improvements in diabetes care.
