



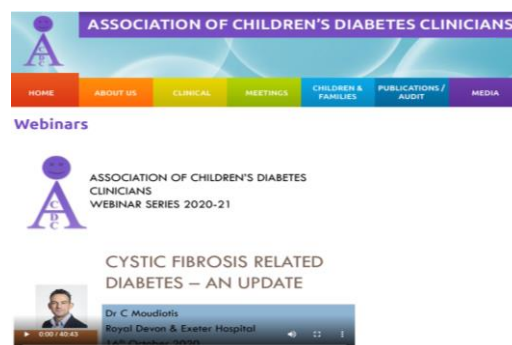

NICE DIABETES IN CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE GUIDELINE UPDATE

NICE Diabetes (type 1 and type 2) in children and young people: diagnosis and management guideline consultation ended on the 21st October 2020. The new NICE publication is expected to be published on the 16th December 2020.

ACDC NATIONAL SURVEYS PUBLISHED
