NICE DIABETES IN CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE GUIDELINE UPDATE

NICE Diabetes (type 1 and type 2) in children and young people: diagnosis and management guideline has been updated and consultation will begin 23rd September to 21st October 2020. The new publication is expected to be on the 16th December 2020.

ACDC NATIONAL SURVEYS PUBLISHED
