ACDC TRAINEES DAY

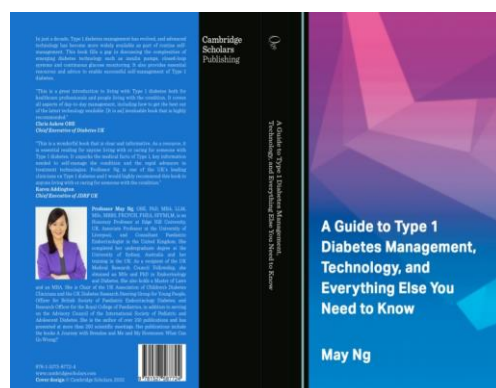
